Dear Families,

Welcome to term 4 and to our new families. We also welcome Deb Parsons (teacher) to our staff. Deb will have numerous roles across the school supporting students with their learning including supporting our transition to school program for our 2024 reception students. Deb will be working Wednesday—Friday. We also welcome a new SSO, Jas who has replaced Tanya who has won a SSO position at another school.

Staffing for 2023 is well underway and we have been lucky enough to have Emily White and Sinéad Tillman appointed to our staff permanently. As we begin to prepare for classes we offer parents the opportunity to send me an email (melissa.evans753@schools.sa.edu.au) with any requests you have based on the needs of your child. We cannot guarantee that your request will be met as there are a number of considerations that we take into account, however, we will be in contact with you if this is the case. Each student is asked for the names of 5 students in their year level who they are able to work well with. This information, parent request information and teacher's knowledge of the students are all included to determine their class placement for next year. The class placement exercise takes considerable time with staff all involved to ensure the mix of our students will set our classes up for success.

HELP is needed on Monday to return our library to working order. If you have a few hours spare Monday morning after drop off please call into the front office and we will set you off to work!





ACTION FOR HAPPINESS




What good things have happened in your life recently?

So although we need to be realistic about life's ups and downs, it helps to focus on the good aspects of any situation – the glass half full rather than the glass half empty!


- Do something that you know will make you feel good. Listen to music, watch something funny, get outside or call an old friend.




Volunteers Needed!!






