Technologies with Matt

This term reception students will be introduced to digital systems, what they are and how they work. The latter half of the term will see us "coding" robots.

Systems thinking

What are the characteristics of a system and what is a digital system?

Electricity

Digital systems use electricity and can be turned on and off.

Hardware

Students are introduced to some internal and external parts of a digital system and understand that these physical parts are called hardware.

Software

Students learn that software is made up of instructions that control a digital system.

Computational thinking

Software is made up of precise instructions that we call algorithms.
